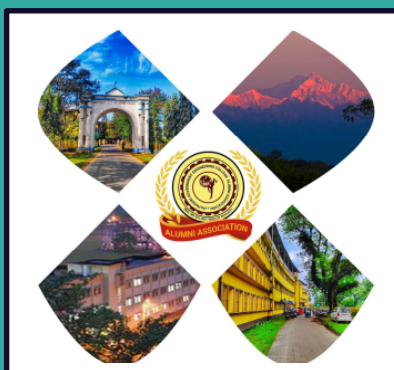

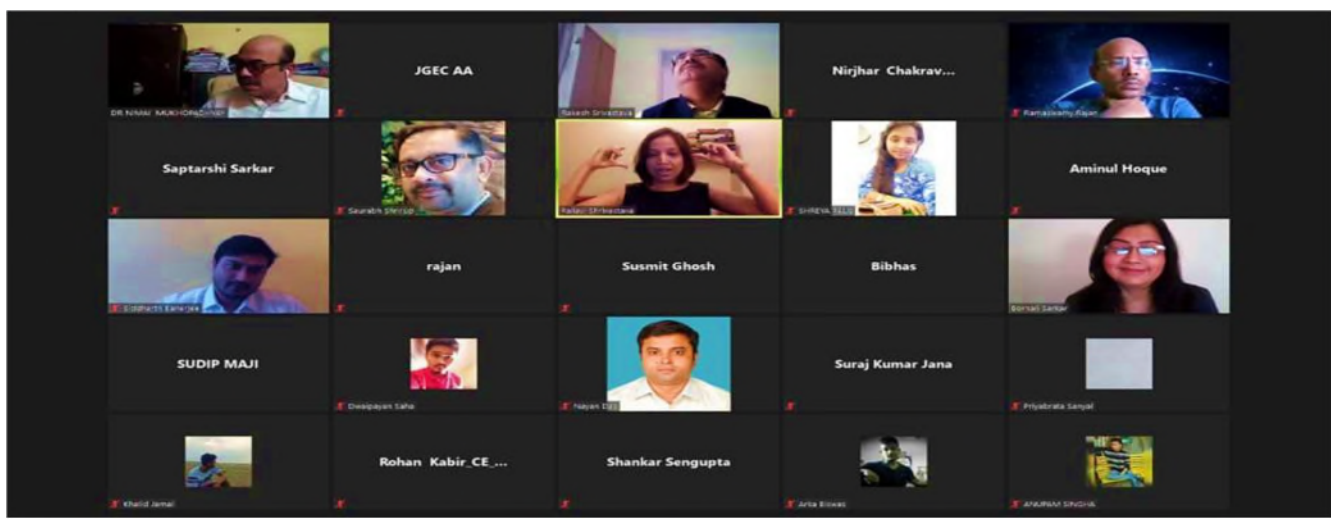

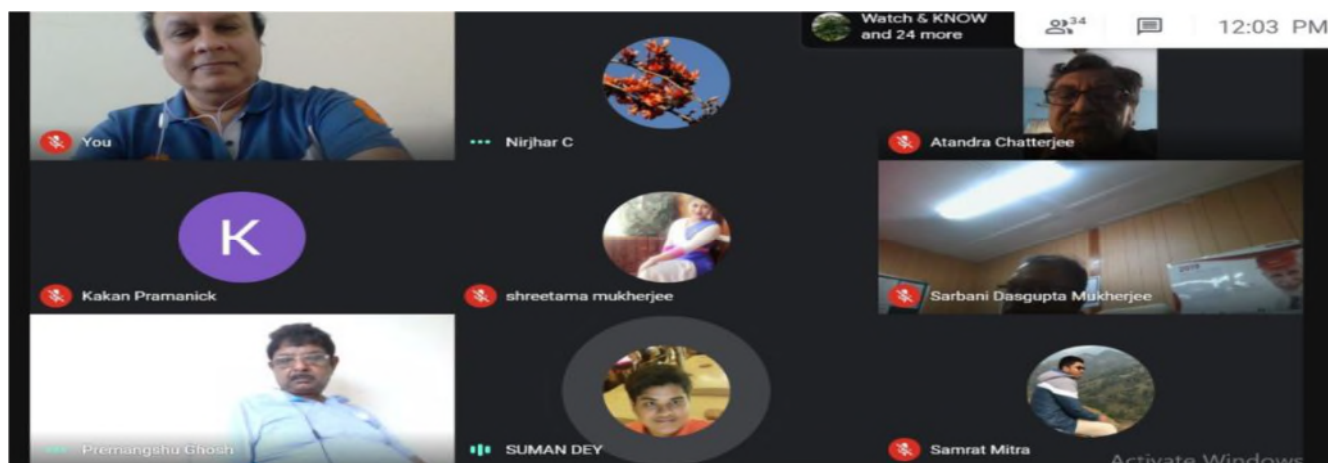


Figure: Glimpses of the online screening program

**Theme: Convention Centre, Building Kanchenjunga, adjacent to JGEC Campus**

**Duration: Continuing since last few years**

### **The event:**

PK is the most prestigious and the biggest focus of AA at present. Ex-students took initiative to build a G+2 Convention Center, Kanchenjunga. **Buy a Brick** is the slogan to showcase the strength of the JGEC fraternity. The first floor has already been constructed and the building is planned to be inaugurated by Mar 2022 (tentative). PK is the symbol of strong willpower of AA mixed with the urge to do something for future generations. It also enhances the brand value of JGEC.

In the middle of the pandemic, Alumni of JGEC and AA has ensured the earning of few daily labors & masons (including plumber and electrician, whenever required) and thus supporting their families as well.

It's all about creating a comprehensive benchmark development centre at JGEC, which will make the alumni extremely proud of. AA is continuously working for uplifting of brand JGEC.

*The detailed construction status of PK is as follows:*

**Phase I:** Building already constructed till first floor, Estimated Rs. 11.0 Lakhs for the remaining work.

*Balance work:*

1. Electrification: 60% area, Estimated Rs. 2.0 Lakhs
2. Tiles Laying: 40% area, Estimated Rs. 2.0 Lakhs
3. Toilets and Pantry fittings and inside & outside plumbing work: Estimated Rs. 4.5 Lakhs
4. Putty work 60% area: Estimated Rs. 1.5 Lakhs
5. Fixing of Doors: Estimated Rs. 1.0 Lakhs

**Phase II:** Furnishing of PK, Estimated Rs. 20.0 Lakhs

### ❖ **Self-sustainable model of PK**

Along with the completion, one target of the AA is to make PK self-sustainable and providing maximum benefit to the students to attain their future goals in life.

With this objective in mind, AA has invited National Institute of Communication Development (NICD), Jalpaiguri within JGEC campus. NICD is a registered educational institution for student's counseling, training, grooming and overall personality development to enhance their employable skillsets. Already many JGEC students are attached with NICD and attend their classes in Jalpaiguri Town. NICD was instrumental to publish JGEC's first science, technology and business magazine Q4U, published by literary society in 2012-13.

With their presence in campus, NICD will now conduct their courses from ground floor of Kanchenjunga, so that students can avail those courses within campus itself and thus, it will help in saving huge amount of time, a key factor in everyone's life in 21st century.

As part of self-sustainable model of Kanchenjunga, the rent from NICD will contribute to ensure a part of regular strategic maintenance expenses of Kanchenjunga as well. NICD will also add values in creating few internal educational facilities inside Kanchenjunga ground floor, which will enable AA to carry out other student-centric programs in future days.
